DISCIPLINE AND GENERAL CONDUCT:

- Student are required to maintain very high standards of discipline, In college premises/ Hostel all acts of indiscipline by the students will be dealt with severely through administrative means.
- Inability to meet the minimum prescribed attendance norms of the university and poor academic performance will render the student liable to be debarred from appearing for exams.

- Identity card must be carried by the student at all times and must be presented for inspection on demand by the college authorities.
- The students are permitted to meet only authorized visitors and guardians. Visitors are allowed only during, prescribed visiting hours. No unauthorized visitors should be entertained by the students in the college/hostel premises.
- Breach of discipline and failure to abide by the rules and regulation of the institute and hostel will render the student liable for disciplinary action.
- Important note: Fees has to be paid as per the Schedule-Admission fees at the time of Registration, Fees / Hostel Fee and Mess charges or before 31st August.

CODE OF CONDUCT

FEES:

In case a student decides to withdraw voluntarily from the institute/ college at any time before completing the course he/ she pay the fees as applicable. Students are requested to pay their college fees on time by way of demand draft only. If not paid penalty shall be levied on him/her. Any change in University fee structure such as eligibility, NSS (National Service scheme) sports fee etc. has to be paid on time.

ATTENDANCE:

HOSTEL REGULATIONS:

- When a student is hospitalized it is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to be with her to make suitable arrangements for his/her needs in the hospital to be attended to.

- Any student who leaves the hostel with permission should get the out pass signed by the parents. On off days' students are not allowed to leave the city without the written permission of the Director/Principal, Parents & Guardian.

LEAVE:

- Special & Medical Leave: Such leave will be granted in case of serious illness. The genuineness of the ground of leave must be granted by the college authority.

- Students cannot avail any leave without teacher's / Principal's permission.

SAY NO TO RAGGING

The Institution follows the policy of zero tolerance to ragging. Ragging is a criminal offence as per the Supreme Court verdict. The Institution shall take the strict action including but not limited to criminal proceeding and / or cancellation of admission against those found guilty and the burden of proof shall here by lie on the perpetrator of alleged ragging and not on the victim.

An offence of Ragging may by charged either on a written complaint by the affected or on independent finding of the Anti Ragging Squad. The institution is bound by the UGC Regulations on curbing the Menance of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions 2008 Punishments against Ragging depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by Committee of the institution, the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging shall be any one or any combination of the following the Anti- Ragging.

- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
- Forfeiting campus placement opportunities recommendations.
- Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
- With holding of results.
- Debarring from representing the Institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
- Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
- Cancellation of Admission
- Rustication from the institution for a period, ranging from 1 to 3 years.
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specific period.
- imposing of Penalty
- Collective Punishment: When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers, in addition, in case of every single incident of ragging, a first Information Report (FIR) will be filed with the local Police authorities.
